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

### Representative Calibration Curve and Sensitivity

The Calibrator curve was fitted with a 4-parameter logistic model with a  $1/Y^2$  weighting. The lower limit of detection (LLOD) is a calculated concentration corresponding to 2.5 standard deviations above the background (zero Calibrator).

### Precision

Controls were made by spiking Calibrator into assay diluent at 3 levels within the quantitative range of the assay. Average intra-run concentration %CV is the average %CV of the control replicates within an individual run. Inter-run concentration %CV is the variability of controls across multiple runs.

### Specificity

To assess specificity, the TNF- $\alpha$  Antibody Set was tested individually against a larger panel of analytes for nonspecific binding (APRIL/TNFSF13, BAFF-R/TNFRSF13C, BCMA/TNFRSF17, BDNF, C-Peptide, CD20, CD27, CD28, CD40L (soluble), CD276/B7-H3, CTACK, CTLA-4, Desghrelin, ENA-78, Eotaxin, Eotaxin-2, Eotaxin-3, EPO, E-Selectin, FGF (basic), FGF-23, FLT3L, Fractalkine, FSH, Galectin-9, G-CSF, GITRL/TNFSF18, GITR/TNFRSF18, Ghrelin (Ser3-octanoylated), gp130 (soluble), GIP (1–42), GIP (3–42), GLP-1 (7–36), GLP-1 (9–36), GM-CSF, Granzyme A, Granzyme B, GR0- $\alpha$ , HAVCR2/TIM-3, HVEM/TNFRSF14, ICOS, ICOS-L/B7-H2, I-309, IFN- $\alpha$ 2a, IFN- $\alpha$ , IFN- $\alpha$ , IL-1 $\alpha$ , IL-

### **Assay Components**

**Calibrator:** TNF-α is included in Calibrator 1. The TNF-α Calibrator is a full-length recombinant protein expressed in *E. coli*.

Antibodies: The U-PLEX Human TNF-α Assay uses a mouse monoclonal antibody for capture and a goat polyclonal antibody for detection.
